Member gets initial communications announcing onsite event

Multiple methods of communication are available from emails and text to digital monitors and flyers to help engage your population.

Onsite appointment gets scheduled

Members can choose from the times and locations convenient to them.

At the onsite event, the member gets a quick blood draw and blood pressure check

A friendly health tech will assist the member in doing a virtually painless blood draw using our state-of-the-art device as well as take measurements. It only takes about 15 minutes.

Samples are overnighted and processed at the Catapult Lab

Each member's sample is processed in our COLA accredited lab located at the Catapult Headquarters in Dallas.

Member schedules a virtual consultation to review results

A few days after their onsite is complete, the member is texted and emailed to schedule an virtual consult with a Catapult nurse practitioner they'll take from the comfort of home.

Virtual consultation takes place

During this the member will review their results, get a Personal Action Plan for the path to optimal health, as well as be referred into any employer-sponsored wellness programs.
